

- Not all tasks show on screen. This is a big nuisance problem to users.

Dragging scroll bar using mouse as far as it will go:

Allocate tasks to groups

Then using scroll wheel on mouse- able to scroll down further:

This is a particular problem for people using a touch pad or an iPad, where a mouse wheel can't be used.
