When updating duration by using scroll button, sometimes the update is not triggered. After changing one duration using the scroll, going down to the next and changing using the scroll- sometimes the "refresh" display shows, sometimes it doesn't- and the update doesn't always take place. I watched this happen with a user- he lost many lines of updates as he went through to put in task durations.

After going from the top task down, and changing all tasks (except the new blank task) to a duration of 3:

This is a bit hard to reproduce consistently. It seems to malfunction more often when clicking on the "down" spin.

The spin controls aren't really necessary. If it help solve this problem it may be worthwhile to consider numeric input boxes instead.
